Boise for Clean Water and Open Space (BCWOS) is submitting this letter to document the PAC's effort to comply with campaign finance disclosure and reporting requirements.

The BCWOS PAC was asked to report an in-kind contribution from The Nature Conservancy after the November 7, 2017 election regarding a mail piece they had sent to their membership in Boise educating them on the open space levy on the November 2017 ballot. The mailer was sent out with the language "Sent on behalf of Boise for Clean Water and Open Space."

The BCWOS campaign and pac was not aware of when or who the mailer was being sent to and did not see a draft prior to it being sent out. BCWOS was not aware that it was being sent "on behalf" of the PAC and did not advise the use of the language "on behalf of."

Because of concern over the disclosure statement BCWOS asked the Boise City Clerk's office how and if we should report this as an "in-kind" contribution. The Deputy City Clerk of the City of Boise, Jamie Heinzerling, advised us to submit our 30-day post general report without it listed as an in-kind contribution, but to provide this letter documenting it.
