ADVISEMENT

HONESTY IS ESSENTIAL

This confidential pre-investigative questionnaire is designed to assist background detectives in conducting a preliminary background screening. Follow up and additional questions will be asked as the investigation continues. Your responses will be verified during a comprehensive background investigation, which includes a truth verification examination and in-depth interviews with you and those who know you.

It is imperative that you answer all questions truthfully. Credibility is vital to this position. We are not expecting to find applicants who have never made mistakes. There is no such thing as a perfect person or perfect candidate. As your prospective employer, we are not looking for perfection; rather, we want an open and honest opportunity to evaluate your qualifications fairly for this position.
